

**IMPORTANT NOTICE:
IMPLEMENTATION OF PER CREDIT FEES
FOR STUDENTS EXCEEDING THE MINIMUM STUDY PERIOD FOR
SEMESTER 2 SESSION 2024/2025**

We would like to inform students that are in Semester 2 Session 2024/2025, who exceed the minimum study period will be charged fees on a per-credit basis. Please refer to UNIMAS Bachelor's Degree Academic Regulations in Article 9 regarding the Study Period.

The per-credit fee structure for students who exceed the minimum study period is as follows:

Programme	Minimum Study Period	Semesters Exceeding Minimum Period
3 years	6 semesters	Semester 7 to 12
3 1/2 years	7 semesters	Semester 8 to 14
4 years	8 semesters	Semester 9 to 14

The implementation of the per-credit fee payment method for students who exceed the minimum study period is as follows:

1. Tuition fees are based on the per-credit fee rate according to the total credits taken in that semester. The rates are listed in the following table:

2. Recurring fees will be charged to all students registered with UNIMAS according to their semester.
3. Students who repeat courses after the minimum study period will be exempted from repeat course fees.
4. Registration in the Intersession will be charged according to the Per Credit Fee rate. Recurring fees will not be charged for Intersession registration.
5. The implementation of the Per Credit Fee does not apply to students from the Doctor of Medicine Program.

Students who have exceeded the minimum study period are required to apply for the Per Credit Fee through the InAFS system. Failure to apply through InAFS will result in students being unable to register for courses.

**MAKLUMAN PENTING:
PELAKSANAAN YURAN PER KREDIT
BAGI PELAJAR MELEBIHI TEMP OH MINIMUM PENG AJIAN
SEMESTER 2 SESI 2024/2025**

Sukacita dimaklumkan bahawa pada Semester 2 Sesi 2024/2025 pelajar yang melebihi tempoh minimum pengajian akan dikenakan pembayaran yuran secara yuran per kredit. Sila rujuk Peraturan Akademik Ijazah Sarjana Muda UNIMAS di Perkara 9 berhubung Tempoh Pengajian.

Struktur yuran per kredit untuk pelajar yang melebihi tempoh minimum pengajian adalah seperti jadual berikut:

Program	Tempoh Minimum Pengajian	Semester Melebihi Tempoh Minimum
3 tahun	6 semester	Semester ke 7 hingga ke 12
3 1/2 tahun	7 semester	Semester ke 8 hingga ke 13
4 tahun	8 semester	Semester ke 9 hingga ke 14

Pelaksanaan kaedah pembayaran yuran per kredit bagi pelajar yang melebihi tempoh minimum pengajian adalah seperti berikut:

1. **Yuran Pengajian** adalah menggunakan kadar bayaran **yuran per kredit** mengikut jumlah kredit yang diambil pada semester tersebut. Kadar adalah seperti jadual berikut:

2. **Yuran berulang** akan dikenakan ke atas semua pelajar yang berdaftar dengan UNIMAS mengikut semester.
3. Pelajar yang mengulang kursus selepas tempoh minimum pengajian akan **dikecualikan bayaran yuran ulangan kursus**.
4. Pendaftaran pada Antarsesi akan dicaj mengikut kadar **Yuran Per Kredit**. Yuran berulang tidak akan dikenakan bayaran pada pendaftaran Antarsesi.

Pelaksanaan Yuran Per Kredit tidak terpakai ke atas pelajar Program Doktor Perubatan yang akan menggunakan kaedah pembayaran yuran pengajian sedia ada.

Pelajar yang telah melebihi tempoh minimum pengajian adalah dimestikan membuat permohonan Yuran Per Kredit melalui sistem InAFS. Kegagalan untuk memohon melalui InAFS akan menyebabkan pelajar tidak dapat mendaftar kursus.
